



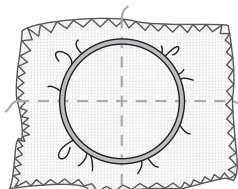

T1 Woolen/acrylic threads RIOLIS

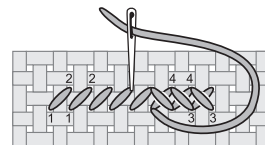
- 1   **463** (4,2 m) light turquoise
- 2   **462** (2,24 m) turquoise
- 2   **462** (0,24 m) turquoise
- 3   **430** (0,32 m) blue
-   white (Ø 3 mm)



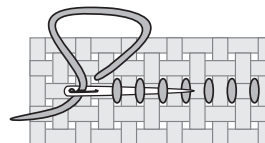

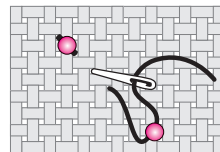

Please read the manual to avoid mistakes!

• The embroidery can be started from any part of the drawing after determining the distance from the center in cells (**T2**).

• A hank of wool is one and indivisible thread (**T3**).

Colors of threads are indicated in **T1**.

• The embroidery is done (**T1**):

× - with 2-strand cross-stitch,

× - with 1-strand cross-stitch,

— - with 1-strand stitch,

○ - with beads.

• The work will look good if all upper stitches are inclined in one direction (**T4**).

• Avoid knots. Hide the thread ends under the stitches of the reverse side (**T5**).

• Iron the finished embroidery from the reverse side.

• Sew beads with the thread № 1 (**T6**, see the cover).
